



The undersigned individuals wish to withdraw the Form filed in accordance with 08 NCAC 02.0111 and with the Pender County Board of Elections filed on November 26, 2006. The purpose of filing the referenced form was not to protest the November 07, 2006 General Election for Pender County Commissioner District 3 and the candidates George Brown, Jr. and Tim G. Baker, but to file an official complaint concerning the high number of under votes in the district contest as compared to the higher number of votes cast in two other County Commissioner district contests. The disproportionate votes not cast in the Pender County Commissioner District 3 votes is a concern and should be investigated thoroughly. Further, is the concern that the voting machines may not have operated properly during the election and within five precincts, Rocky Point, Upper Topsail, Lower Topsail, Surf City and Scotts Hill.
