The Hampstead Fire Department is requesting to be added to the agenda on the 9th of July to present the information for the purchase of a replacement piece of apparatus.

This apparatus will be replacing 2 pieces of apparatuses that the department currently own. The first is a 1974 Ford Pumper truck that will go into reserve status. The next piece is a 1983 van that we use for a service unit. This apparatus is not designed to carry the weight that is on this truck it is unsafe to drive and is a liability to the department. By combining these two into one truck we will save the taxpayers approximately \$200,000.

The county debt ratio of 25% will not be exceeded with the purchase of this truck.
