

Dear Ms. Brill;

The Town of Wallace has within the last year begun a new initiative to address storm drainage problem thru out Town. I have enclosed a copy of a power point briefing used at a community meeting. The only effective way to address overall drainage is to begin at the discharge point and work upstream.. Based on this the Town recently spent \$19,700 to mow/clear approximately 3 miles of Little Rockfish Creek to where it's empties into Rockfish Creek. Rockfish Creek is the sole drainage basin for a large area of Pender and Duplin County including all of the Town of Wallace. On Wednesday July 18th I met with Mr. Norwood Blanchard to show him the Town's initiative and to discuss the possibility of Pender County clearing the south side of Rockfish Creek from Little Rockfish to the Northeast Cape Fear River. I have also met with Duplin County Commissioner David Fussell to see if Duplin County could clear the North side of this same stretch of creek. Mr. Blanchard asked that I write to you and see if this issue could be added to the agenda for your August 6th meeting. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me.
