

**RESOLUTION BY THE PENDER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:  
COUNTRY CLUB ROAD AND U.S. HIGHWAY 17 TRAFFIC SIGNAL LIGHT**

**WHEREAS**, Country Club Road is one of the most heavily traveled roads in Pender County and has only one outlet to U.S. Highway 17; and

**WHEREAS**, the backup created by the single outlet and high volume of traffic creates potential hazards for residents, especially during morning and afternoon commutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the developers of St. George's Reach have committed to purchasing the "landing strip" parcel and constructing on it a public road which will provide an additional access from U.S. Highway 17 to Country Club Road; and

**WHEREAS**, this additional outlet will greatly alleviate the potential hazards from the backups caused by the single outlet as well as reducing the traffic flow on Country Club Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the new road will provide an alternative route so that construction traffic does not overburden Country Club Road; and

**WHEREAS**, a traffic light at the new road will provide the greatest common good by improving the safety on both Country Club Road and U.S. Highway 17.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Pender County Board of Commissioners that the North Carolina Department of Transportation is respectfully urged and encouraged to authorize and approve a traffic signal light for the road to be constructed on the landing strip property in order to alleviate traffic on Country Club Road, allow a safer route for construction and promote the common good.
