**RESOLUTION BY THE PENDER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:
MAINTENANCE OF DRAINAGE OUTFALLS**

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation, in years past, maintained drainage outfalls in Pender County; and

WHEREAS, approximately eight years ago the decision was made by the Department to discontinue this practice; and

WHEREAS, since that time the lack of maintenance has led to outfalls becoming overgrown and blocked by the infill of silt and debris; and

WHEREAS, these conditions have caused severe drainage problems within the county and related health and safety concerns.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pender County Board of Commissioners hereby respectfully requests that the Department of Transportation rescind its decision to discontinue the maintenance of drainage outfalls and take necessary steps to implement an effective system of drainage outfall maintenance in Pender County.
