

**PROCLAMATION BY THE PENDER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
RECOGNIZING PENDERLEA HOMESTEAD MUSEUM DAY 2008
FOR COMMEMORATING THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF
PRESIDENT FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT'S NEW DEAL PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the New Deal was a sequence of programs established under President Franklin D. Roosevelt between 1933 and 1938 that brought relief, reform and recovery to the people and economy of the United States during the Great Depression; and

WHEREAS, as a response to the struggle of urban and rural families, communities were planned by the federal government under the auspices of the Resettlement Administration; and

WHEREAS, Penderlea Farms was established in 1934 as one of the first such farmsteads of the New Deal; and

WHEREAS, Penderlea Homestead Museum is housed in an original home, one of the first ten built in Penderlea and the former residence of Greg and Sula Murphy; and

WHEREAS, the Penderlea Homestead Museum will commemorate the 75th anniversary of President Franklin D. Roosevelt's New Deal during Penderlea Homestead Day on Saturday, June 14, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that, the Pender County Board of Commissioners do hereby recognize Penderlea Homestead Museum Day 2008 for Commemorating the 75th anniversary of President Franklin D. Roosevelt's New Deal.
