REQUESTED BY: Jack Griffith, Ph.D., Director, Pender County Health Department

SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing an Amendment to Approve Increase in Health Department Revenues and Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2009-2010: \$7,000

BACKGROUND: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has awarded mini grants of \$3,000 to local health agencies. Through this partnership with local health agencies, the Immunization Branch of the Division of Public Health seeks to provide preventive health measures through the administration of vaccine to age appropriate populations within the state.

Pender County Health Department will utilize the additional funding to improve the administration and distribution of state supplied vaccine to Pender County residents.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: The board is requested to approve increasing programmatic revenues and related expenditures for Pender County Health Department by \$7,000 in the Immunization program for Fiscal Year 2009-2010.
