Resolution to Prohibit Illegal Aliens from Attending North Carolina's Community Colleges

WHEREAS, the Pender County Board of Commissioners recognizes that the United States is a nation made up of legal immigrants who have made significant contributions to our nation's history, economy and culture; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of North Carolina's community college system is to educate North Carolina's legal residents for employment; and

WHEREAS, it is illegal in the United States of America to employ illegal aliens, and

WHEREAS, the United States provides guest worker programs whereby non-residents are allowed to work legally in the United States under such programs; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2009, the North Carolina State Board of Community Colleges supported their committee's recommendation to allow illegal aliens to enroll in North Carolina's Community Colleges, and

WHEREAS, although the policy must still make its way through the administrative rules process and could subsequently be allowed or disallowed by the North Carolina General Assembly; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pender County Board of Commissioners unanimously approves a resolution against this decision by the North Carolina State Board of Community Colleges; and that the Pender County Board of Commissioners will forward the resolution to the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners, to the State Board of Community Colleges and to the General Assembly for further action; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the North Carolina General Assembly, especially those representing Pender County, including Sen. R.C. Soles, Rep. Sandra Spaulding-Hughes and Rep. Carolyn Justice, work diligently to prohibit illegal aliens from enrolling in the North Carolina Community College system.
