SHORT TITLE: Carol Eakins, Chief Probation/Parole Officer for Pender County: Presentation of Annual Report of Criminal Justice Partnership Program; Approval of Board Members; and Resolution Approving Execution of Criminal Justice Partnership Program Continuation Grant For Fiscal Year 2010-2011: \$74,614, and Authorizing Purchase Orders for Delivery of Mandated Counseling Services

BACKGROUND: This will be the thirteenth (13th) year that Pender County has received this grant. The program sponsors and funds contractual services with sexual offender treatment providers and substance abuse treatment providers for counseling and follow up with parolees in order to prevent recidivism.

The Pender County Criminal Justice Partnership Board voted unanimously to approve the submission of this grant application at their March 10, 2010 meeting. Funding from this program provides treatment as mandated by court.

The Criminal Justice Partnership Board has approved the budget as set forth in this resolution. Purchase Orders should be approved for CDTEG -Chemical Dependence Training Evaluation and Guidance, Inc., in the amount of \$52,612 and to Richard Banton (Center for Research and Prevention of Recidivism) in the amount of \$19,691.

These are process funds that pass through the County and are expended without County supervision. Financial decisions are made by the CJPP Board. The composition of the Board is delineated by the enabling legislation and the attached roster of proposed members complies with those parameters.

Staff recommends approval of this resolution.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: The Board of Commissioners is requested to approve and authorize execution of a continuation contract with the NC Department of Corrections

Criminal Justice Partnership Program in the amount of \$74,614, to approve purchase orders for delivery of mandated counseling services, and to approve the membership of the CJPP Board.
