The people out here are mostly Senior Citizens with limited income including myself and don't have the money to pay a contractor for something that should have been done when the property was sold as lots.

We pay property taxes, fire and rescue, vehicle taxes and don't have much to show for it in the form of road improvement. When the county brought in the water system the contractor that put it in mess up the road even worst and did not fixes it back. I called the county and complained that the contractor made some new holes and trenches and did not fill them in. The county said that they looked at it and could not find anything, just passed it off just like anything else. The school kids out here walk a little over $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile in the cold and thru the muddy road to get to the paved road where they wait in the cold to meet the bus. The bus got stuck in the mud sometime back and ever since then the bus turn around where the pavement ends. Some of the parents have to leave early for work to early for the parents to take the kids to the bus stop so they are stuck. Its either leave early for work and have a job or come in late from taking the kids to the bus stop and not have a job.


