SHORT TITLE: Presentation of Water & Sewer District Population Distribution Analysis

BACKGROUND: One of the objectives resulting from the Board planning summit in January was to evaluate unserved and underserved areas of the county for potential expansion of the county's public water system. More specifically, one of the action items was to conduct an initial assessment of the population distribution and density for the Columbia-Union, Central Pender and Moores Creek water and sewer districts. The purpose of this assessment is to assist in developing an expansion feasibility report for these areas, including whether or not the districts could be reconfigured to enable cost-effective and economical water service to be provided in high population density areas.

The Planning Department has completed the population distribution and density assessment, and would like to present the findings to the Board. The next step in the process would entail developing a more detailed water system expansion feasibility report for presentation to the Board no later than March 31, 2011.
