SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the County Manager to Dispose of Surplus Personal Property Valued at Less than \$2,500

BACKGROUND: The North Carolina General Statutes authorizes a city or county to authorize an official (typically the Manager) to dispose of surplus personal property valued at less than \$2,500 for an item or group of items. The purpose of this is to allow local governments the ability to efficiently dispose of surplus personal property items. Historically, the Board has allowed the Manager to set the price and dispose of personal property, but not under a formally adopted policy or resolution. It is recommended the Board adopt a formal policy authorizing the County Manager to declare surplus property, set the fair market price, and sell the property. The statute provides that records be kept of property sales under this policy.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider a resolution authorizing the County Manager to declare surplus items of personal property valued at less than \$2,500 for an item or group of items, set the fair market value of such, and convey title to the property as provided for in accordance with GS 160A-266(c).
