SHORT TITLE: Resolution Approving a Purchase Order to New Hanover County for the Purchase of One Used 2001 Ford Nine-Passenger Prisoner Transport Van: \$5,700

BACKGROUND: On September 15, 2010, William Britt was transporting prisoners when he was involved in an accident located on Highway 53 in Maple Hill, NC. The estimated damages exceed the actual cash value and were declared a total loss. Insurance payment was received in the amount of \$5,025.00. New Hanover County offered the Pender County Sheriff Department to use a 2001 Ford Prisoner Transport Van they no longer needed in their fleet. They recently offered Pender County to purchase the described van in the amount of \$5,700. The amount quoted is within the NADA market value. After discussion with Capt. Jones, Pender County Jail Supervisor, and Sheriff Carson H. Smith, Jr., it was agreeable by all to purchase the van to support their needs. It was approved by the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners on February 21, 2011 to sell the Transport Van to Pender County. Due to the excellent condition of the van, it is recommended by the Pender County Public Works Department to purchase one 2001 Ford Nine-Passenger Prisoner Transport Van from New Hanover County.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider a resolution to approve the purchase of one used 2001 Ford Nine-Passenger Prisoner Transport Van from New Hanover County in the amount of \$5,700.
