SHORT TITLE: Resolution Requesting Consideration to Unfreeze Two Environmental Health Positions

BACKGROUND: The Pender County Health Department's Environmental Health Program is short-staffed and faces daily challenges to meet the demands of the public. In addition, the state environmental health program has adopted the Federal Food Code for implementation. This will require many new changes in the Food & Lodging program. This is to request one Program Specialist for the On-site Waste Water program and one for Food & Lodging.

In 2010 four Environmental Program Specialists were laid off and the positions were frozen. On March 8, 2012, the Board of Health agreed that two of the positions need to be unfrozen. The salary and fringe will be \$61,149 per employee.

This item was tabled from the April 16, 2012 meeting.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider a resolution to unfreeze two Environmental Health Program Specialists positions at a cost of \$122,298
