SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing, Empowering and Commanding the Tax Collector of Pender County to Collect Taxes.

BACKGROUND: N.C.G.S. 105-321 (b) requires the Governing Board to enter into its minutes an order directing the Tax Collector to collect the taxes set forth in the tax records filed in the Office of the Pender County Tax Collector. This order shall be a full and sufficient authority to direct, require, and enable the Collector to levy on, sell real or personal property of such taxpayers, for and on account thereof, in accordance with law.

Required Annually in accordance to format G.S. 105-321 (b)

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider approval of the order authorizing the Tax Collector to collect taxes set forth in the Office of the Tax Collector.

Such taxes are hereby declared to be a first lien upon all real property of the respective taxpayers in the County of Pender, and this order shall be a full and sufficient authority to direct, require, and enable you to levy on and sell any real or personal property of such taxpayers, for and on account thereof, in accordance with law.
