SHORT TITLE: Presentation by 4-H delegate on attending the NCACC Youth Summit held on August 17-18, 2012.

BACKGROUND: A 4-H'er from Pender County attended the third annual North Carolina Association of County Commissioners (NCACC) Youth Summit, which was held in Raleigh, North Carolina August 17-18, 2012. North Carolina 4-H and the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service partnered for the third year with the NCACC on a multi-year initiative to increase youth involvement in county government. This initiative aims to overcome the mindset that many youth are disengaged and lack trust in government. The 4-H'er who attended from Pender County was Ryan Teeter of Hampstead, NC.
