SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing Adoption of the Survey of the County Boundary between Onslow and Pender County that was Performed by the North Carolina Geodetic Survey.

BACKGROUND: Pender County was formed in 1875 from New Hanover County; however, the county line between Onslow and Pender Counties had never been surveyed. The North Carolina Geodetic Survey was contacted in 2007 to identify the location of the county line between Onslow and Pender County. Since then, the North Carolina Geodetic Survey has researched and worked with both counties in acquiring data and documents to assist in the identification of the county line. The North Carolina Geodetic Survey finalized their research and determined the location of the county line based on historical maps and field surveys. With previous consent from both Counties' Board of Commissioners, the North Carolina Geodetic Survey has placed monuments at nine area locations along the line and has mapped the lines connecting these locations. The North Carolina Geodetic Survey is requesting approval of the surveyed county line boundary by each county. Upon approval by both Counties, map(s) of the survey will be recorded in each county and will also be placed in the North Carolina Secretary of State Land Records Office. With the surveyed county line, Pender County stands to gain over 8,000+ acres.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider approval of the preliminary county boundary line agreement presented by the NC Geodetic Survey.
