SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing Transfer of K-9 to Original Trainer/Owner for Rehabilitation

BACKGROUND: The Sheriff's Department used seized drug funds to acquire a Belgian Malinois (Czaki) for use in narcotics detection. The original handler of the dog is no longer employed with the Department, and the dog has become unsuitable for performing its duties. The original trainer of the dog is willing to attempt to rehabilitate the dog, assuming all responsibility for the dog including care, feeding and additional training. While no tax dollars were used to acquire the dog, the County Attorney recommended that the Board approve the transfer.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider a resolution approving the transfer of a Belgian Malinois dog (Czaki) to Jason Cummings in return for Mr. Cummings accepting responsibility for the dog.
