REQUESTED BY: Carolyn Moser, Health Director, Pender County Health Department

SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing a Budget Amendment to Approve Increase in Health Department Revenues and Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2013-2014: Migrant Health \$14,425

BACKGROUND: The Office of Rural Health and Community Care allocated an additional \$11,925 in funds for Medical and Dental assistance to migrant and farmworkers. And, another \$2,500 was allocated for migrant and seasonal farmworkers to have access to otherwise costly prescription medications. The program will pay the co-payment to pharmacies on migrant and seasonal farm workers medications at participating pharmacies.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider a resolution approving a budget amendment for increasing additional programmatic revenues and related expenditures for Pender County Health Department by \$14,425 in the Migrant Health program for Fiscal Year 2013-2014.
