SHORT TITLE: Resolution Authorizing Approval of Annual Settlement of the Pender County Tax Collector,

BACKGROUND: N.C.G.S. 105-373 (a) requires the Tax Collector to make an "annual settlement," which indicates unpaid taxes for the current year as well as prior years. The annual settlement is the real and personal property taxes left "on the books" at the close of the fiscal year (June 30, 2014). The amounts consist of Pender County Taxes, Solid Waste User Fees, Fire Tax, Rescue Tax, and Town Taxes. Making the annual settlement, this does not mean the Tax Collector will cease pursuing collections.

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED: To consider a resolution approving the Annual Settlement of the Pender County Tax Collector.




