SHORT TITLE: Public Hearing to Name and Address Rileys Way and Becks Lane

BACKGROUND: Under the authority and provision of the General Statutes of North Carolina, Chapter 153A-239.1, a county may by ordinance name a road and reassign street numbers for use on such a road. The statute requires that a public hearing be held on the matter.

According to Article III, Section 302 A., of the Pender County Road Naming Ordinance, when a public or private road provides access to more than 3 residences, businesses, industries, or combinations thereof, regardless of the length of such road, a road name shall be assigned. The property owners shall provide Pender County a petition with the proposed road name.



According to Article I, Section 103 of the Pender County Property Addressing and Display Ordinance, as conditions merit, such official numbers may be changed upon proper official notice to the property owner and public agencies.

There are four existing structures and 1 new structure between the two roadways. These structures will receive new addresses if the road naming request is approved.

The Legal Notices have been properly posted and the residents have been notified by mail. A petition is also on file.
