SHORT TITLE: Approval of Purchase Order in the Amount of to \$534,257 to PlayWorld Preferred for Playground Equipment and Installation at Hampstead Kiwanis Park and Pender Memorial Park.

BACKGROUND: In November, 2015 Pender County was awarded \$550,000 for the Play Together Construction Grant from Trillium Health Resources for inclusive playground equipment that will allow and encourage engaging play between able bodied and handicap children. Staff advertised a Request for Proposals for designs of inclusive playground equipment for Hampstead Kiwanis Park and Pender Memorial Park. Four proposals were received from the following vendors: Burke, Carolina Parks & Play, Carolina Recreation & Design, and PlayWorld Preferred. A committee consisting of three Parks and Recreation Advisory Board members and two staff members was formed to review the proposals. Based on their design and their ability to do a turnkey job, the committee chose PlayWorld Preferred.

Funds for this project are budgeted in Capital Outlay- Playground Equipment 60-407400-6033.

Request for Proposal Inclusive Playground Equipment Hampstead Kiwanis Park & Pender Memorial Park January 29, 2016

Project Description: Pender County is planning to make improvements to Hampstead Kiwanis and Pender Memorial Parks thanks to a grant from Trillium Health Resources for inclusive playground. The new playground equipment will expand and enhance the existing playground at Hampstead Kiwanis Park and replace the existing playground equipment at Pender Memorial Park. Project design must be approved by Trillium Health Resources by March 31, 2016 with project completion required by August 31, 2016.

Proposal Format: Qualifying proposals for this RFP must include all items listed in Inclusive Playground Specifications. All proposals should include detailed cost information according to the specifications as well as all applicable labor, installation, freight, taxes and related appurtenances. Please submit a separate proposal for each park's playground.

Please be advised that this is a request for proposal process, not a straight bid or quote process. Proposal reviewers will take into account factors such as design, project specification, warranty information and references in regard to selection. It is our desire to select a product that provides the community with the best value and the most play components while meeting the needs of individuals with varying abilities.

Minimum Required Items for Proposal:

1. Detailed product specification and warranty information with color designs
2. Site plan
3. Detailed quote for project
4. Approximate timeline of project from Notice to Proceed
5. Proof of Insurance Coverage
6. References

Inclusive Playground Specifications:

- Play equipment that accommodates ages 2 – 12.
- The Liberty Swing which is manufactured in Australia is a requirement of the project and must be enclosed with a fence and shaded. The fence and shade color should coordinate with the other play equipment. Play and/or visual panels should be used on fences where possible to create a more inclusive atmosphere. This swing will be located at Hampstead Kiwanis Park.
- A combination of 4-6 swings that will accommodate tots, youth/adult, and adaptive that will allow for physical support of those with special needs.
- Play component layout, additional play equipment, height, and design is opened to the vendor's creativity provided the layout and equipment meets all required safety standards.
- All proposed equipment must be International Play Equipment Manufacturers Association (IPEMA) and American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) certified, and must meet Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
- The sub grade should contain appropriate grading for drainage.
- The surfacing requirement is poured in place rubber with colors to coordinate with equipment. The entire surfacing area should meet all fall requirements.
- For the Pender Memorial Park proposal include the removal of existing 5 – 12 equipment and swings and the relocation of them to Hampstead Kiwanis Park.
- For Pender Memorial Park proposal include 2 – 3 benches around the perimeter of the playground.
- For the Hampstead Kiwanis Park proposal include 3 – 4 benches around the perimeter of the expanded playground.
- The play area must be ADA accessible and the play facility must provide a variety of components that will encourage and allow for inclusive play for all individuals and must consider varying ranges of physical and mental abilities.

Financial Information: The Hampstead Kiwanis and Pender Memorial Parks Playground Projects are under the scope of a Trillium Health Resources grant in the amount of \$550,000. The total project budget, net of North Carolina sales tax, should not exceed **\$550,000** for all equipment, surfacing, site preparation, installation, shipping, and all items listed in Inclusive Playground Specifications for **both** playground projects. Each park project should be submitted as separate proposals. Therefore, it is possible to be selected for one park project and not the other.

Qualifying proposals must be received by TIME DATE.

CONTROLLING TERMS: An order or acceptance of products by customer constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions in their entirety, without regard to any terms and conditions contained in any document of customer, even if they are additional to and not in conflict with these Terms and Conditions.

PRICES: Prices are subject to change without notice. Unless otherwise stated in writing, all prices are F.O.B. Lewisburg, PA, and shall be exclusive of transportation, insurance, taxes, license fees, customs fees, duties, premiums, fees, installation expenses and other charges. Any such taxes, fees and charges will, at Playworld Systems, Inc. option, be added to the price, paid directly by the customer or reimbursed by customer if paid by Playworld Systems, Inc..

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Unless credit is specifically granted in writing by Playworld Systems, Inc., payment in full is due upon delivery. All payments for products released and shipped on approved credit accounts shall be due in full and in legal tender of the United States (unless otherwise indicated by Playworld Systems, Inc. on the invoice) thirty (30) days from the date of invoice thereof. If Customer fails to perform the terms of payment of any invoice or if the financial condition of Customer shall become impaired or unsatisfactory to Playworld Systems, Inc., Playworld Systems, Inc., in its sole discretion, reserves the right to change the terms of payment, require payment in advance or security or a guaranty satisfactory to it and/ or defer or discontinue further shipments without prejudice to any other lawful remedy available to Playworld Systems, Inc..
