Rigid plastic containers - such as soda and water bottles, sports drink and juice bottles, along with laundry detergent and milk containers must be separated from your trash. Look for the RECYCLING DUMPSTER at your local site – ask the attendant. Throw your aluminum cans and glass in there along with your newspapers and recycle all together!
Simple and easy!!

Wooden pallets – must be broken down and can be disposed of in the C&D bins at the Rocky Point, Burgaw, and Willard Convenience Centers. Large loads, in excess of 200 lbs., must be disposed of at the Hampstead Transfer Station, and will be charge the current per ton rate.

Used oil filters - can be disposed of in the filter bins at the Rocky Point or Hampstead Convenience Sites.
