

To whom it may concern,

We had solar panels installed in our backyard by Greg Yurick. He installed the poles too close to the property line as you can see from the survey. The poles are 7'2" from the property line and they should be 15' from the property line. I'm only 7'10" short of the property line. The poles are already installed in the ground and would be too hard and costly to move. They are galvanized steel six inches in diameter, they are cemented three feet in the ground, The poles are able to sustain up to 150 mile hurricane winds. There is common ground on the side of the house and behind the house. We didn't do anything to cause a hardship. No one is behind us and we have a six foot fence around the property. No one can be hurt. Our backyard is totally enclosed. You cannot see the solar panels from the street. Our gates are locked. I need forgiveness so that I can get the permit, so the electrician can file for the permit for the electric. I hope this is enough, if not don't hesitate to call me at 910-270-3849.
