of these pesky insects.**




We know you'll enjoy summer picnics, ball games and swimming pools better if you don't have too many mosquitoes. Have fun this summer!




People may become very sick from diseases which mosquitoes carry.



Mosquito bites can also make your dog sick! They carry dog-heartworm disease.



Mosquitoes which aren't killed when they are small become adults and fly around. Adult mosquitoes are sprayed at night when they are the most active with very small amounts of chemical. You will see these trucks in your neighborhood. Boys and girls should NEVER follow a truck or ride bikes through the spray.



**Fish and frogs help to control mosquitoes too. They eat the immature mosquitoes. It's a good idea to put fish in farm and ornamental ponds.**



**Mosquitoes always need water to breed and grow. Be sure to empty your wading pools and toys after it rains. Ask your Mom and Dad to repair any areas of your yard which collect water which remains for 7 to 10 days. Don't raise mosquitoes!**



Mosquitoes are attracted to light. Light traps are used to collect mosquitoes. Light trap collections can tell us what kind of mosquitoes are bothering you and how many mosquitoes are in your neighborhood.



Mosquito control workers use special chemicals to kill mosquitoes while they still are small. Only the safest chemicals are used and our workers are very carefully trained.
