



Become a Precinct Official

Serve your community! Make new friends! Be a part of the election process.

Qualifications to become a Precinct Official

Must be a Pender County resident and a registered voter

Must not be a candidate or relative of a candidate in the election

Must not be an elected government official, hold office with a political party or be manager or treasurer for a candidate or political party

Must not serve at the same polling place as a spouse, child, spouse of a child, sibling.

Requirements of Precinct Official

Must have reliable transportation to and from the polling place

Must work all day on Election day (6a.m. to approximately 9 p.m.)

Must assist with the setup of election supplies and voting equipment on the Monday evening before Election Day

Must not promote or discuss any candidate, political party, policy or cause while working on Election Day

Must attend all required training classes before each election

Must work on Election Day in order to receive payment for attending training

Early Voting

One-stop early voting begins the third Wednesday before an election through the Saturday before an election.
