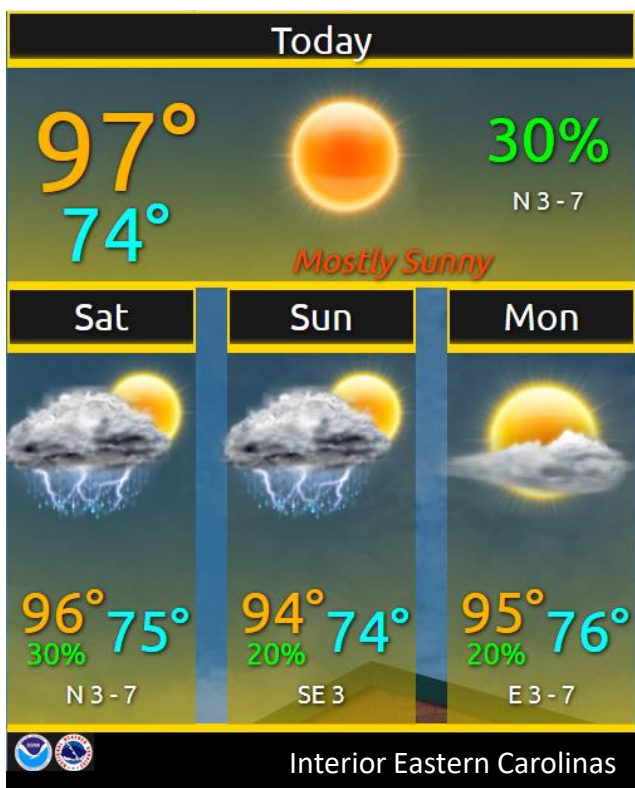
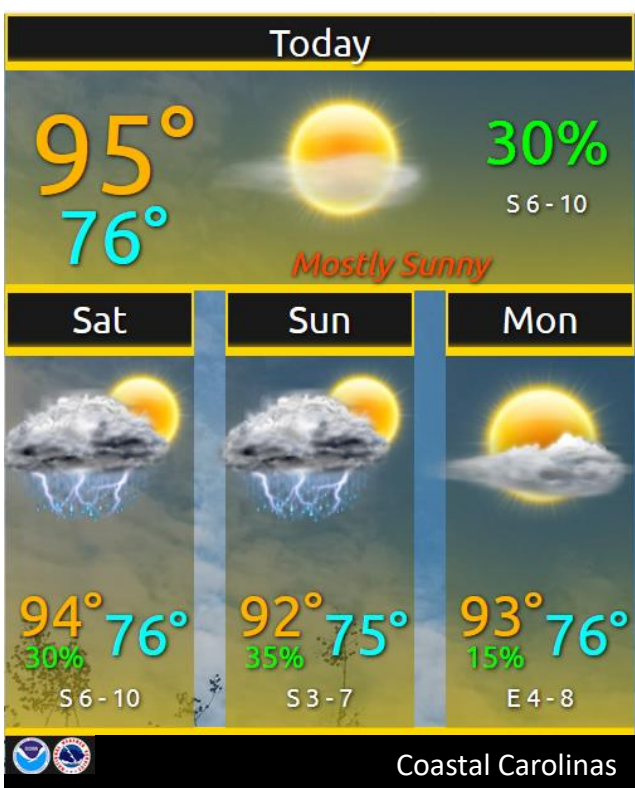

...Heat and humidity to continue through the weekend...

Overview: High temperatures in the 90s with high humidity will produce daytime heat index values between 100 and 105 degrees today, Saturday, and again Sunday. A weak front will reach the eastern Carolinas on Saturday and should stall near the coast on Sunday, increasing the potential of scattered afternoon showers or thunderstorms.

Impacts: High heat index values may make prolonged outdoor activities hazardous. If the heat index is forecast to reach 105 degrees for three hours or more, a Heat Advisory will be issued.



Forecast Rainfall through Sunday Night: Average amounts around one tenth of an inch with spotty amounts near half an inch.
