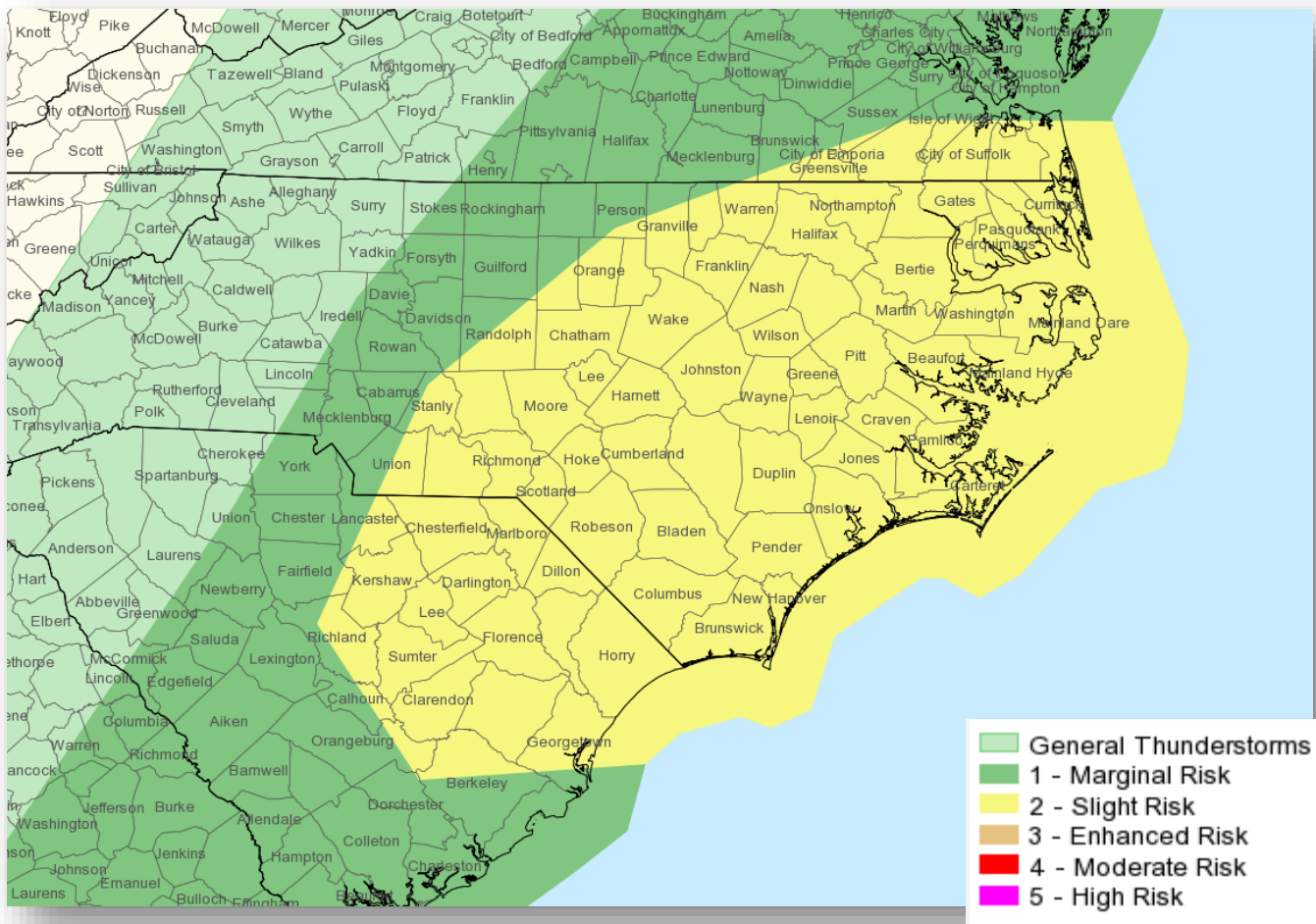

**...Risk of severe thunderstorms Tuesday, otherwise dry until late week...**

**Overview:** A cold front will move across the area during Tue resulting in scattered showers & tstms, some of which may be severe. Dry weather will prevail Wed-Fri morning. Another front will approach during Fri afternoon/night resulting in additional rainfall chances.

**Impacts:** Slight risk for damaging wind gusts Tue along with a risk for isolated tornadoes. The risk will be greatest during the day Tue with conditions improving by Tue night.



**Forecast Rainfall Amounts through Friday Night:** Average a quarter inch or less, possibly a half inch to an inch across far northwestern areas.
