Cold Front to bring Cooler Temps, Breezy Conditions on Saturday

Overview: A weak disturbance will bring sprinkles or light rain showers this evening ahead of a cold front. Northeast winds increase behind the front on Saturday morning, as high temperatures fall into the mid-50s. Rain chances return Sunday evening, especially in coastal NC, with the development of a weak coastal low.

Impacts: No significant land-based impacts expected. For our mariners, expect rough seas 4-5 feet due to NE winds 15-25 knots with gusts up to 30 knots Saturday and Sunday A.M.

Timing/Confidence: Small Craft Conditions possible Sat. through Sun. morning.



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
