Respondent shall take this Addendum into consideration when preparing and submitting its Statement of Qualifications.*

Questions and Answers

Question 1: Section 3 of Requirements requests “Qualifications and experience of personnel who would be performing design services . . .” Please confirm that Subsection 3a, Items i, ii and iii, do not apply to the resumes and/or bios for proposed personnel but do apply to project descriptions?

Answer 1: I don’t have any particular expectation of where in the SOQ this information should be provided. Your suggestion for their location is acceptable, as long as it is clear that any personal experience of team members while with other firms is not portrayed as current firm experience.

Question 2: Has the RO Plant site been determined?

Answer 2: Not yet. We are working on some potential sites, but it is not yet definitive. Note that the conceptual RO Plant location noted in the CDM Smith report is not likely to be the actual anticipated plant location.

Question 3: What are the key issues and/or concerns for the project?

Answer 3: The schedule dictated by our current funding source, as well as gaining permit approval for the concentrate discharge, are our biggest project concerns. There is a relatively tight turnaround required for the engineering report/environmental information document, and the deadline for bid & design package approval will likely make the design and approval of the discharge point the critical path.
